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	 We will have to develop additional procedures for field trip to help streamline the process for staff. Absence team is contacting families, and now MTSS is looking at total absences. Families are also being contacted for tardies by absence team. Teachers are encouraged to also have conversations with families that have excessive tardies that they are missing instruction, and that information does inform families that are not invited back for the next school year.
